Deacon Jeff's Corner

When I arrived here over five years ago now, the statue of the Virgin Mary was always over in the corner where we now have a statue and icon of St. Michael. Her image would be brought to the side of the sanctuary for the months of May (month of Mary) and October (month of the Rosary), and always put back in the corner following each month. As a strong believer in the power of the intercession of our Mother Mary, I'm so glad she is now on the left side of the sanctuary along with St. Joseph.

Legend has it that a follower of St. Paul, Dionysius, whom Paul would baptize and in time name him the Bishop of Athens, went to meet the Virgin Mary at her home in Ephesus. Following that encounter, he wrote this about his experience to St. Paul:

"I have seen with my own eyes the most holy Mother of our Lord Jesus Christ, who surpasses in sanctity all the angels of heaven. By the grace of God, the good favor of the Apostles, and the unutterable goodness and mercy of the blessed Virgin, I was granted this meeting. Again, I confess before the Almighty God, before the grace of the Savior, before the great glory of the Virgin, His Mother, that when I was introduced to the beautiful and most pure Virgin together with John, who while living in the flesh shines like the sun in Heaven, a great divine radiance shone about me from without and lit up my soul. At the same time, I sensed such a wonderful fragrance that my spirit and body could hardly bear this manifestation of glory and foretaste of eternal bliss. From divine grace and glory, my heart and spirit were prostrated. That moment in time for me was one of extreme happiness!"

Can you imagine such an experience? I believe with all my heart that the Virgin Mary will take our requests to her Son, Jesus, and ask him to grant these prayers according to His perfect will. Take your cares, concerns and desperate hopes to her; she will go to her Son for help!

The Miracle of Faith

In today's first reading we hear, "God did not make death, nor does He rejoice in the destruction of the living".

The gospel goes on to portray not one, but two incredible miracles Jesus worked that truly defied death and suffering – the raising of Jairus' daughter and the healing of the hemorrhaging woman. What both Jairus and the woman have in common is that they both demonstrated deep faith in Jesus.

I think for various reasons, we often don't ask Jesus for what we need. Maybe it's a false sense of humility, maybe it's fear our prayer will go unanswered, maybe it's simply that we just haven't spent enough time in silence with our Lord to even KNOW what to ask for. "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." – Matthew 7:7-8

Spent some quiet time with Jesus. What is on your heart today? Where do you need grace and healing, in your own life or for someone close to you? I challenge you to be bold in your faith and ask Him – but just make sure you are ready for the answer! We also know that God often answers our prayers in a different way than we expect. More often than not, I think it takes a lot of time for us to understand His ways. Even the apostles were usually confused at what Jesus was doing! Take heart, because if we stay close to Jesus and our faith we know that all things will be revealed.


