



Why Reject the Ones We Love the Most? by Deacon Dennis

On the tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we heard in the Gospel of Mark that Jesus returned home with His disciples. His greeting from His extended family had shown Him a great dishonor and today, four weeks later, that dishonor is also shared by the people who listened to Jesus teach in the synagogue. Jesus was not able to perform any mighty deeds in His hometown because His power could not take effect due to the people's lack of faith. They questioned His wisdom and His authority.

How many times, do we cause someone we know and love to perform to a lesser capacity because we question their wisdom, their authority, and listen with skepticism? Or we wonder if their training gave them the appropriate opportunity to learn..."Is He not the carpenter, the Son of Mary?" Jesus comes today as a teacher. Adult men took turns explaining the scriptures in the synagogue. The fact that Jesus took His turn at explaining the scripture was fine. What upset the listeners was what He said, the content of His message. The gospel today says that "many who heard Him were astonished." However, they were not astonished in a good way, for they took offense with Jesus.

Many times, we can extinguish a person's enthusiasm and passion by our hurtful comments, unsolicited advice and our facial expressions that can tell the receiver a lot. If it comes to our children or grandchildren, our spouse, our co-workers or people we serve with on committees, please be aware of how our comments can squash their eagerness and willingness to serve. Do your questions and queries come from awe and amazement or from resentment and bitterness?

Remember to say thank you and be appreciative of someone's help and suggestions. May all of our thoughts, words and actions aim at doing what is pleasing in God's sight!


