

Deacon Jeff's Corner

One of the many gifts the Catholic Church has imparted to us is the saints and the example each one of them has set for us. None of them was perfect in their earthly life, but they continually strived to live their life for Jesus.

One of the saints we honor in July (July 6) is St. Maria Goretti. Maria was murdered by her live-in neighbor, Alessandro Serenelli, at the tender age of 12. Alessandro approached Maria when she was alone to rape her. When she refused and told him repeatedly he would be committing a grave sin, he stabbed her 14 times. The wounds pierced her heart, lungs and even her intestines. Although in 1902, doctors did all they could to save Maria (pouring salt and vinegar into her wounds), she died 24 hours later. For the hours following the mortal injury she suffered, she continued to forgive Alessandro for his heinous act. The news of the murdered child who forgave her assassin attracted thousands, who came to pass by her coffin.

But it wasn't only her death that drew so many to her funeral, but also her life. So let me explain briefly how St. Maria Goretti lived. She was born into a poor family, the third of seven children. When she was nine years old, her father passed away from malaria, forcing her mother and siblings to work every day in the fields, while Maria was the designated housekeeper and watched her youngest sibling.

Alessandro had tried to rape Maria several times before he murdered her, but she always resisted and told him of the mortal sin he was committing. He was sentenced to 30 years in prison. One night dreamt of Maria holding fourteen lilies to present him, with her forgiveness. In a discussion with a bishop, Alessandro asked for forgiveness for his sins. Once released from prison, he joined the Order of Friars Minor Capuchin, living in a monastery as a lay brother until his death in 1987.

The cause for Maria's canonization began shortly following her death and culminated with her canonization in 1950 by Pope Pius XI. He called Maria, "the St. Agnes (also a martyr) of the 20th century". She is the patron saint of chastity, rape victims, girls, youth, teenage girls, poverty, purity, and forgiveness. If you have a young girl in your family, the story of St. Maria would be a wonderful lesson! As with all the saints, ask St. Maria for her intercession; I think you will be pleasantly surprised!



"God Doesn't Call The Qualified, He Qualifies The Called."

As I re-read the scriptures several times this quote, I heard kept coming to mind: "God doesn't call the qualified, He qualifies the called." Have you ever felt a nudge (a call), like Amos and the disciples to do something? I know I have, and sometimes I follow the nudge and other times, I don't. I guess that is where free will, and the gifts & fruits of the Holy Spirit come in. We are given the choice to believe or not to. Our faith and trust to know what we are doing is truly God's will, not just our own will or want. John writes in ch.15; "It is the work of the Holy Spirit that conforms us to the image of Christ. 
