## Deacon Jeff's Corner



Have you ever heard the phrase, "God writes straight with crooked lines?" Many times, we cannot understand – good or bad - why things happen the way they do. If you are a person of faith, and if you are reading this, I am guessing you are, you must question why things happen the way they do at times, and why God allows such bad things to happen.

There are a few answers to this question, and since none of us are God, the answers I give you may not suffice for what goes on in your life. First, since Adam and Eve, sin has been a part of our world. God offers each one of us the grace (undeserved love) to navigate the challenges that face us, but many times we prefer to go it on our own. When we choose to reject God's love, believe it or not, God "reroutes" us. To use an analogy, think of using your GPS to get you to a particular destination. When you make a wrong turn or you think you know better and choose to ignore the directions, the voice doesn't scold you. Rather, it simply recognizes you made wrong choice and immediately shows you how to get on the right track again. To me, that is a great image of the grace of God. We are making wrong turns all the time. It is the stubbornness of each one of us to say, "Lord, I've heard your voice in Scripture, in the liturgy, through the sacraments, and especially in the Eucharist and Sacrament of Confession. I know it's the right way... but no, no, no, I'm going to make this wrong turn." In God's love for you, he allows you to make this mistake, reshuffles the deck, and finds a way to get you back on track.

I write this about myself more than anyone of you. But I say this to reaffirm your choice to be here, to experience God's love for you, to worship God together as a "family", and to remember that trusting in God especially during the most difficult times will get you through – IF you are able to trust!

### All You Need Is Love

*by Deacon Bill*

People around my age might recognize the title of this article as also the title of a song written by John Lennon and released by the Beatles in 1967. It seemed like a simple solution to relationship problems as well as lots of complicated issues that were going on in the world, most notably the Vietnam War. All you need is love and everything is going to be OK. As they say, “I know, right?”

In the gospel for this weekend, we hear Jesus quote from the Book of Deuteronomy, the first reading for Mass. When asked what is the first, therefore the greatest commandment, Jesus basically says that we are to love God with everything we’ve got and adds that to love our neighbor as ourselves makes the commandment to love the greatest there is.

That word “love” can have lots of meanings for lots of people. It can range from the passionate feelings between two young lovers to an addiction to chocolate and everything in between. So what is it that Jesus is calling us to? We kind of know what God is about, at least as much as our faith can tell us. In the parable of the good Samaritan, Jesus tries to explain that our neighbor can even be someone we’ve been taught to despise. It seems that Jesus’ command to love can be confusing.

Maybe the best way to deal with the confusion is to ask ourselves what or whom do we put ahead of ourselves. If we can honestly say that God and other people take priority over our own wants and needs, we might be close to understanding what Jesus tells us are the greatest commandments. Might be a bit more difficult than dealing with a list of “thou shalt nots.”




