## Deacon Jeff's Corner

Today we celebrate the Fourth (and final) Sunday of Advent, with the celebration of Christmas only a few days away. If you are willing, allow me to reflect on a few of my thoughts.

When God came to earth as one of us 2000 years ago, he came to change the world. As we prepare to celebrate his birthday, that mission can pretty much be listed as "accomplished". Jesus took twelve very ordinary men, and through his example of love and peace sent them out to spread the Good News that he had begun. To look at one tiny microcosm of that work, I thought we should take a look at the parish family of Prince of Peace Catholic Community in Green Bay, Wisconsin. Is the work of Jesus being done here? Is God someone I follow every day, or only on occasion? If I say I am a member of this parish family, do I help whenever possible, or only on rare occasion?

Allow me to say this: Every day that I wake up and spend one-on-one time with God, I am "over the top" grateful for the opportunity to serve every one of you. This part of my life has been one of my greatest blessings. My hope and prayer for every one of us is to make God a "daily event". Talk to God, thank God, give your challenges to God. Most of all, no matter what you do: If you are a student, laborer, homemaker, career-oriented, retiree, and everything in between, please make God a part of your day – every day! If you can make the mission of Jesus a part of your everyday activities, he will walk with you and change your life! May all the blessings of Christmas and love of the baby Jesus be with you and remain with you throughout the coming year. Merry Christmas!

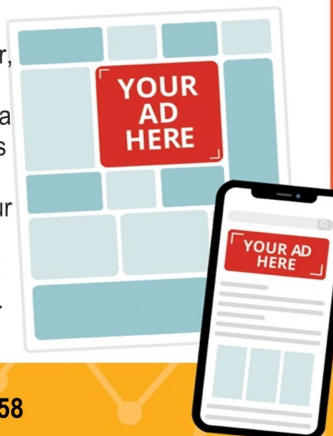

On this last Sunday in Advent, we hear of Mary's journey to visit her relative Elizabeth, an older woman who was expecting her first child. That child, we know, is destined to be the great John the Baptist, the one who would call the people to prepare for the Lord's coming. Elizabeth is excited. Her unborn baby is excited. Then Elizabeth says something very profound. "Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled." Mary was called blessed because she believed. A promise had been made to her by a messenger from God. That promise would be fulfilled and Mary had faith enough to put her hope and trust in that promise.

On the day of our baptism, each of us, represented by our parents and godparents, made promises to God, promises that we would hopefully learn of one day and be able to make ourselves. As important as those promises were and are, there was another promise made that day. Our God, a God who doesn't go back on promises, was promising us that God would always be with us, walking with us in good times and bad. As we enter the Christmas Season, I think it would be a good idea for all of us to reflect on those promises, ours and God's, and to ask ourselves how fulfilled we feel because of them.

Jesus was born into this world so that God could become one of us and that we could know, from the life of one who was truly a human being as well as being God, that the promise is real, for us, and that all we need to do is accept it with all our hearts, living as people who have accepted the promise. What could be more fulfilling than that?
